Monthly Pay — helping you budget

Looking to spread your premium payments over 12 months? Need to define your own monthly premium payment date? Look no further!

With Monthly Pay, you have the flexibility to choose a monthly payment date. Installments are automatically withdrawn from your chosen bank account on the date specified with an original billing notice sent to you directly.

Variable Pay (VPay) — as easy as 1-2-3-4

With VPay you can choose from four payments with premiums split over the chosen term. The first installment is always free with subsequent installments requiring a nominal \$6 service charge when paying by cheque.

Payments can be made via automatic Electronic Funds Transfer, without a fee or with a cheque or money order. A \$6 per cheque/ money order installment fee is applicable to the 2ND, 3RD and 4TH installments. The first installment is always fee-free.
